## Dress code guidelines

## Dress code violations:

**First offense:** Students are sent to the Administration to change (if clothes are available) and parents/guardians are notified. If the dress code issue cannot be resolved, the student will be in ASP for the remainder of the school day.

**Second offense:** 1 day ASP

**Third offense:** 2 days ASP

**Fourth offense:** 3 days ASP
